OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject: Participation by Central Government employees in sporting events and tournaments of national/international importance.

The undersigned is directed to refer to this Department's O.M. No. 6/1/85-Estt(Pay-I) dated 16.07.1985 enumerating the incentives/facilities available to the Central Government employees on achieving excellence in sporting events of national/international importance. As indicated therein, tournaments/championships conducted by recognized National Sports Federation are treated as events of national importance.

2. Issues raised with regard to the applicability of provisions contained in the OM dated 16.07.1985 were clarified vide this Department's OM No. 6/2/85-Estt.(Pay.I) dated 30.01.1989. An updated list of recognized National Sports Federations, as furnished by M/o Youth Affairs & Sports, was also circulated vide this Department's OM No. 6/2/2004-Estt(Pay-I) dated 18.03.2008.

3. In continuation of the above, it is informed that M/o Youth Affairs & Sports, D/o Sports, vide their letter No. 8-23/2020-SP.III dated 29.07.2021 granted recognition to the Ju-Jitsu Association of India as National Sports Federation for promotion and development of the sport of Ju-Jitsu in the country with immediate effect with the condition that it shall comply with the provisions of National Sports Development Code of India, 2011, as modified from time to time, and other relevant guidelines issued in this regard.

4. In view of the above, name of the Ju-Jitsu Association of India is added at Serial No. 66 of the list of recognised Sports Federations circulated vide this Department's OM dated 18.03.2008.

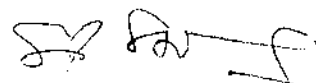

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- (c) The Federation must maintain its accounts as per the Mercantile System of accounting. The Accounting year should be from 1st April to 31st March. The books of accounts shall always be open to inspection by authorized representatives of the Government.
 - (d) The accounts of the Federation must be audited by a practicing Chartered Accountant empaneled from CAG. Audited Statement of account should be sent to the Union Government within six months from the date of expiry of the accounting year.
 - (e) The Federation must scrupulously abide by the guidelines of the Govt. issued from time to time, for the conduct of national Championships, drawing of advanced calendar for holding National Championships, players' grievance system in the management of the federations, etc.
 - (f) The Federation should also abide by the directions of the Government issued, if any, in the interest of promotion of sport among its players or Public in general.
 - (g) The recognition can be reviewed by the Govt. in case Memorandum of Association (MoA)/ Constitution of the Federation or its practices come into conflict with the Govt. Guidelines as amended from time to time.
 - (h) The Ministry's Guidelines for selection procedure shall be followed by the Federation. The tournaments shall be held for Men & Women at all levels i.e. National, State, District level for Senior, Junior and Sub-Junior categories.
 - (i) The Federation shall scrupulously follow the Ministry's guidelines on RTI applicability and suo-moto disclosure of information on its website and appointment of a Public Information Officer and an Appellate Authority.
 - (j) The Federation shall ensure strict compliance of the Government guidelines to prevent unethical practices in sports such as age fraud, prevention of sexual harassment of women in sports, Anti-doping, issuance of identity cards to sportspersons, etc.
4. The Ju-Jitsu sport is placed in the 'Others' Category.
5. The recognition may be withdrawn if:
- a) any of the terms and conditions of the recognition are violated;
 - b) its own Constitution is violated;
 - c) directions issued by the Union Govt. are not complied with as required;
 - d) in the opinion of the Union Govt., the Federation is not functioning properly;
 - e) the recognition has been obtained by submitting false information or by misrepresentation of fact;
 - f) the concerned international Federation cancels affiliation or derecognizes or disaffiliates the Federation.



6. This grant of recognition is subject to compliance of the Provisions of National Sports Development Code of India, 2011, as modified from time to time, by the Federation. A copy of the National Sports Development Code of India, 2011, currently in force is available on the website of this Ministry i.e. <https://yas.nic.in/sports/national-sports-development-code-india-2011>.

7. The requests for financial assistance and clearance of proposals must be submitted in the prescribed manner. Assistance may be provided to the Federation subject to the availability of funds, submission of the relevant documents, fulfilment of the terms and conditions/ guidelines etc., as may be prescribed from time to time.
